As part of the MISTA closing ceremony the results of the MISTA 2013 Challenge was announced. The challenge (from the web site) was:

"In the context of the 6th Multidisciplinary International Scheduling Conference (MISTA 2013), the CODeS research group of KAHO (Engineering Technology, KU Leuven) is organizing a challenge with the goal of stimulating research in scheduling. The challenge deals with the multi-mode resource-constrained multi-project scheduling problem (MRCMPSP) in which multiple projects have to be scheduled, while taking into account the availability of local and global resources."
